Monthly report December 2016

Strong finish to the year: NAV up +0.6%

- Net performance since inception +7.7%
- All strategies have exhibited positive performance during the month
- New direct debt investment in Vestcom International

In December, Partners Group Generations Fund gained 0.6% and closed the year at a NAV per share of GBP 1.077. Performance was mainly driven by the Fund's direct and secondary investments such as KinderCare Education and Project Barium. Project Barium, a real estate secondary investment, recently experienced an increased valuation of an underlying hotel asset in Nashville, TN, as a result of improving trading numbers.

Amongst the best performing liquid investments were APA Group and Eurazeo. The latter, a listed direct investment company, successfully completed several sales and realized a profitable partial exit of Moncler. Further, the Australian gas pipeline operator, APA Group, also contributed positively to the Fund's performance due to more transparency on possible future regulations. Additionally, the company has replaced an expiring contract for gas transportation with AGL Energy.

In December, the Fund made a debt investment into Vestcom International in support of Charlesbank Capital Partners' acquisition of the company from Court Square Capital Partners. Headquartered in the US, the company develops and produces shelf-edge communication solutions primarily for food and drug retailers. For example, Vestcom's proprietary 'stackz' product allows retailers to quickly reflect price changes through adhesive labels on store shelves. Such solutions enable the company's clients to reduce store operating expenses and improve shopper engagement, driving incremental sales. In 1985, Vestcom introduced the outsourcing of shelf-edge media to retailers and remains the market leader in the US.




Portfolio composition
